Additional surcharge for hazardous cargo	€ 110.00
Charge for extra stop in case no deviation occurred. Extra kilometers are charged according to the real distance of the extra trip which took place.	€ 100.00
Waiting cost per day in the Netherlands	€ 550.00
Waiting cost per day in the United Kingdom	€ 720.00
Surcharge for loading/unloading on Saturday	€ 180.00
Surcharge for loading/unloading on Sunday / Bank holiday	€ 225.00

First 5 working days are free, including day of arrival vessel, and after that charges, rate per day or part thereof:	€ 50.00
Terminal storage of a unit delivered by road will be charged from day 1, rate per day or part thereof:	€ 50.00

4 CONTAINER DETENTION	
First 10 calendar days are free, onward charges per container, rate per day or part thereof:	€ 10.00
